Family Camps 2021: Week 3 and beyond

Currently, the limitation on public gatherings, including church and chapel services, permit multiple separate groups outside of 150 people physically distanced, and inside of 50% of capacity to a maximum of 150 people physically distanced. We continue to move forward with modified services for Week 3 and beyond in summer 2021. We expect that soon announcements will be made which may relax restrictions further which we will update everyone with.

Family Camp Week 3:

1. All services:

- a. Wherever you sit (inside or outside), you must be physically distanced from people outside of your household.
- b. As per current health orders, when **inside masks must be worn** by anyone five years of age or older.
- c. Morning services for pre-school, children and junior youth are at 10 am. Evening services will be at 7 pm. For evening services all groups go directly to their chapel location.

2. Adult services will be in the Tabernacle inside and outside:

- a. As seating will be limited, it will be first come, first serve. In some situations, if gatherings outside get near 150, we will require that people sit inside the building if the outside capacity is met (and visa-versa).
- b. The speaker will be preaching from the west middle doors and facing the outside.
 - i. A video camera will show the speaker on the TV's and projector screen inside.
 - ii. The sound system will cover both inside and outside the Tabernacle.
 - iii. In case of rain an FM transmitter will broadcast the service which should be reachable throughout the camp. If you don't have a radio, we will have a limited number of radios available to purchase or borrow (\$20 – refundable if returned).
- c. Seating:
 - i. Outside seating: Bring a lawn chair, sit on your ATV or in your golf cart or car. We can have 150 people outside. The area we count is from the South Lakeshore Drive through the area outside the tabernacle through to the Solid Rock café. If people can be seen from the preaching position within this area, you will be counted towards the 150.
 - ii. Indoor seating: There will be seating for 150 people inside entering at the foyer/nursery entrance. Seats and aisles will be marked off to show availability.

3. **Nursery** will not be provided this summer.
4. **Preschool** will be held in the Preschool Chapel building.
 - a. Preschoolers should be dropped off before 10 a.m. and picked up around 11:15 a.m. for the morning service, or before 7 p.m. and picked up after 8:15 p.m. for the evening service.
 - b. Up to 20 preschool children will be allowed.
5. **Children's services** will be held in the Children's Chapel.
 - a. Children's services are for those entering Kindergarten to those entering Grade 5.
 - b. Children should be dropped off before 10 a.m. and picked up after 11:15 a.m. for the morning service, or before 7 p.m. and picked up after 8:15 p.m. for the evening service.
 - c. Up to 75 children will be allowed at either service offering.
6. **Youth services** will be held in the Youth Chapel.
 - a. Youth services are for those entering Grade 6 and above.
 - b. Youth services are at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.
 - c. Up to 75 Jr. youth will be allowed at either service offering.
7. **Health requirements and restrictions for ALL services:**
 - a. All attendees must enter and exit from the area/building following posted routes.
 - b. Everyone must daily ensure that they are healthy and can make a declaration of good health prior to attending any activities or services.
 - c. Normal registration for Plan to Protect will continue to be used.
 - d. Physical distancing is required when seated outside of households.
8. **Travel from Outside of Manitoba:**
 - a. currently anyone who is entering from outside Manitoba or has been outside of Manitoba in the past 14 days must either self-isolate for 14 days or be fully immunized (which means 2 vaccine doses with 14 days elapsed since 2nd dose).
 - b. We discourage any campers from completing their self-isolation at Manhattan Beach.

9. Food Services:

- a. Lunch (11:30) and Supper (5:30 pm) will be plated meals
 - i. seating will be available both inside the dining hall (50% seating limitation means up to 160 seats), plus outside on the picnic tables and for take-out.
 - ii. as per regulations, persons can sit together at an inside table if they are:
 1. they all reside in the same private residence, or
 2. a combination of persons and anyone over age of 12 are fully immunized
 - iii. As per regulations purchasing food and eating will be required to provide contact information at the time of purchase (regardless of seating inside or outside). MBRC must retain this information for 21 days and then destroy it.
- b. Night snack will be served as take-out only starting at 8:30 pm.
- c. The Store will operate again from the side room of the Retreat Centre.

10. Pool:

- a. We are allowed 50% of capacity, or no more than 94 swimmers in the pool at a time.
- b. Daily pool time registration will begin at 12:45 p.m. each day at the pool. If required to manage occupant load, sign up for pool times will be for 1-hour timeslots. If spots are available, people can remain in the pool.
- c. The pool will be open from 1:00-5:00 p.m. each day.
- d. Swimming lessons continue to be held. See www.mbrc.ca to sign up.

11. Mini-Golf:

- a. Up to 36 people can be in the mini- golf at a time.
- b. The mini-golf will be open from 1:00-5:00 p.m. each day

12. Laundry:

- a. Only 1 person allowed at a time in the laundry room.
- b. Machines must be sanitized after you have used them.

13. Office:

- a. Only 1 household allowed at a time in the office. Please wait outside for your turn.
- b. Masks are always required inside the office.

14. Store:

- a. The Camp Store will be in the Dining Hall again this summer.
- b. Store hours will be from 1:00- 5:00 p.m. and 8:00- 9:00 p.m. daily.
